This order shall dispose of a batch of three writ petitions as the  
issues involved in these petitions are identical.

The petitioners have approached this Court for seeking quashing  
of communication dated 10.01.2017 (Annexure P-14) passed in CWP-6860 of

2023:PHHC:044519

2017, whereby the respondents had restrained the petitioners from operating the vehicles (Autos/Taxies) from the Railway Station premises.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the grievance of the petitioners has seemingly been redressed and does not survive any longer. He contends that the policies are issued annually by the respondents and that the petitioners would be satisfied in case the respondent-Authorities consider their respective claims as per the applicable policy.

Needless to mention that there can be no presumption regarding the respondents not considering the claim(s) of the petitioners in terms of the policy so framed by them. Hence, there is no reason for passing any pre-emptive order. Since the entitlement, if any, of the petitioners was to continue using the parking space for the said year as per the annual circular issued, the present petitions are disposed of as not pressed at this stage.

This is without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner(s) to file fresh petition, if any, on any renewed cause of action.
