AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellants No.1 & 2 in equal share.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two cheques for Rs.2,25,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Twenty Five Thousand only) each favouring appellants No.1 & 2, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 30.12.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
