This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned decision/proceedings dated 22.09.2021 Annexure P-1 and order dated 29.10.2021 Annexure P-6, with a further prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioners to continue in service till they attain the age of superannuation.

2. By a detailed order dated 10.11.2021 noticing the contentions as raised by counsel for the petitioners, notice of motion was issued. However, during the pendency of this writ petition, the petitioners, who had continued to work till they attained the age of superannuation, have since retired. In this respect, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 has produced the office orders dated 27.05.2022 of petitioner No.1-Mohammad

Ali, dated 27.09.2022 of petitioner No.2-Ram Pal Yadav and dated 10.03.2022 of petitioner No.3-Subhash Chander. The same are taken on record. Copies thereof have been handed over to the counsel for the petitioners.

3. In view of the fact that the petitioners herein have superannuated, the prayer in the present writ petition has rendered infructuous and it is disposed of as such.
