By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C for seeking the transfer of the investigation of the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.0059 dated 05.05.2023 registered at Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala, under Sections 406, 498-A and 120-B IPC, from the local police to Crime Branch, Punjab at Chandigarh.

Mr. Gurlal Singh Dhillon, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of all the respondents in this case in pursuance of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Ripan Kumar from the afore-referred Police Station, he informs the Court that the inquiry /investigation has already been conducted and concluded by the S.P, Head

Quarters, Patiala and the cancellation report has also been prepared in respect of the criminal case under reference and now, the same is pending before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, for the necessary approval for its presentation in the competent Court.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, it becomes explicit that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous. Resultantly, the same stands dismissed accordingly.
