Prayer in the instant petition is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to grant parole to the petitioner to enable her to meet her minor son as despite application for parole having been filed by the petitioner and process in respect thereto having been initiated by the jail authorities vide dispatch No.7894-99 dated 29.06.2022 and reminder in respect thereto having been given on 05.05.2023 (Annexure P/1), no decision has been taken on the application of the petitioner, despite the same required to be taken within 42 days from the date of submission of the application.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner would be satisfied if the instant

petition is disposed of by directing the competent authority to take a decision on the application submitted by the petitioner within a specified period of time.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Surender Pannu, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition by directing respondent No.2 to take a decision in the matter by passing speaking order within one week from today and communicate the same to the petitioner within the aforementioned period of time, failing which, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the instant petition.

6. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.

7. A copy of this order be furnished to the learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, under the signatures of the Bench Secretary, to enable him to forward the same to respondent No.2 to ensure compliance.
