LISA GILL, J.

This appeal has been filed by the appellant – wife challenging judgment and decree dated 19.08.2013 passed by the learned Additional District Judge (Adhoc), Fast Track Court, Amritsar, whereby petition under Section 13(1)(1A)(1B) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent – husband was allowed and marriage solemnized between them on 18.02.2006 was dissolved.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that during pendency of this appeal, matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. Terms and conditions of the settlement were reduced in writing on 10.02.2023. Said compromise dated 10.02.2023 furnished in Court today is taken on record as Mark A, subject to just exceptions.

It was agreed that consolidated sum of ₹12.50 lakhs would be paid to the appellant by respondent – husband on the basis of which

appellant would withdraw this appeal. It is submitted that Demand Draft dated 02.02.2023 for a sum of ₹6 lakhs had been handed over to the appellant on 10.02.2023. Today, Demand Draft dated 22.03.2023 for a sum of ₹6.5 lakhs has been handed over to the appellant, present in Court. Photocopies of demand draft dated 02.02.2023 and 22.03.2023 are taken on record subject to just exceptions.

At request and with consent of learned counsel for the parties, appeal, which is listed at serial No. 773 on regular Board, is taken up for hearing today itself.

Appellant, duly identified by her counsel, present in Court submits that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. She states that she has received the entire agreed amount of ₹12.50 lakhs and in view of settlement dated 10.02.2023, she seeks to withdraw this appeal. She further states that she would also withdraw the Execution Petition in the matter under Section 125 Cr.P.C. Statement of the parties to this effect have been recorded separately.

Keeping in view the settlement as has been arrived at between the parties, present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.

Pending application(s), if any, are disposed of accordingly.
