JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to issue him passport.
2. An FIR No.102 dated 20.09.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 427, 506, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') was registered against the petitioner at Police Station Payal, District Khanna. The police after completing investigation has presented its report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. The petitioner has presented an application before the Trial Court seeking direction to passport authority to reissue his passport. An order dated 10.10.2023 passed by the Trial Court reads as:

“An exemption application has been filed on behalf of the accused Prabhjeet Singh, considering

the averments mentioned in the application, same is allowed for today only.

Today case was fixed for prosecution evidence. No PW is present today. Let PW at sr.no. 1 to 4 be summoned withailable warrants and remaining PW at sr.no.7 & 8 be also summoned for 05.12.2023.

An application for directing the concerned Regional Passport Authority Chandigarh to re-issue the passport to the applicant under provisions of section 6 (2) (f) Passport Act 1967 is filed. Now for filing reply to the said application come upon date fixed.”

3. On being confronted with aforesaid order, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdrawn the present petition with liberty to pursue his remedy before the Trial Court. He further prays that Trial Court may be directed to consider application of the petitioner in a time bound manner.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty
5. The Trial Court is requested to decide application of the petitioner expeditiously.
