The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to release the capital subsidy alongwith interest at the rate of 6% per annum.

Reply by the respondents had been filed on 03.10.2018 wherein they have submitted that the claim of the petitioner was found to be not maintainable for want of compliance of necessary conditions of the policy and for non-submission of requisite documents as per the mandatory conditions. The petitioner was thus found deficient in compliance of condition of Rule 2.22 of the Industrial Policy of 1996. Consequently, the petitioner unit was held to be not entitled for the subsidy. No replication/rejoinder to the aforesaid reply has been filed. Opportunity was extended again and again to the counsel for the petitioner to complete instructions. On the last date of hearing i.e. 20.01.2023, learned counsel for the petitioner had made a specific statement that she is not able to contact with the petitioner and as such had no instructions in the matter. She sought time to complete instructions.

On resumed hearing, today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. The averments made in the reply have also remained uncontroverted. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing his case.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
