1. Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned orders dated 07.02.2000 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.4 dismissing the petitioner from service for remaining absent from service, with a further challenge to the orders dated 30.08.2000 and 11.05.2001 (Annexures P-7 and P-9) passed by respondents No.3 and 2, respectively.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to seek alternative remedy, in accordance with law.
3. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
