By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to take legal action on the representation dated 27.11.2020 (**Annexure P-5**) submitted by the petitioner against private respondent No. 6 and not to call the petitioner or his family members at police station on repeated complaints made by respondent No. 6.

[2] This Court, while issuing notice of motion vide order dated 21.12.2020, passed the following order:-

“ The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action on the representation dated 27.11.2020 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner against respondent No.5 and for transfer of complaint dated

01.10.2020 submitted by respondent No.5 from Jalandhar to Jagraon.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that respondent No.5 has made complaint dated 01.10.2020 to respondent No.3 against the petitioner and other family members and the petitioner and his family members are being harassed by the police by calling them to the police station again and again.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

Pursuant to supply of advance copy, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

Learned State Counsel seeks time to complete his instructions and file reply.

Adjourned to 22.02.2021.

In the meanwhile, any further action on complaint dated 01.10.2020 shall remain in abeyance. ”

[3] In response to above order, short reply by way of affidavit dated 22.03.2021 of Sh. Palwinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Jalandhar, on behalf of respondent No. 1 to 5 stood filed, wherein it has been mentioned that petitioner was neither called by the local police nor any threat perception, as alleged, has been expressed or substantiated by him.

[4] Learned State Counsel also assures the Court that the representation dated 27.11.2020 (P-5) made by the petitioner will be considered as per law.

[5] In view of the above, learned counsel for petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[6] **Disposed off** accordingly.
