1. The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.410 dated 26.05.2014 under Section 174-A of the IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Karnal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court on or before 25.08.2023. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Rahul Mohan, Sr. DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to

the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court on or before 25.08.2023. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

6. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 25.08.2023, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously, by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
