By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the quashing of the FIR bearing No.41 dated 12.06.2023 registered at Police Station Sandhaur, District Malerkotla, under Sections 354-A, 294, 341, 506 & 509 IPC, along-with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Mr. Iqbal Singh Mann, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Davinder Singh from the afore-referred Police Station, he apprises the Court that the investigation is still continuing and thus, the Challan has not yet been presented in the Competent Court, in connection with the criminal case under reference.

3. In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned

State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage, while submitting that if there need be, the petitioner would file a fresh petition for seeking the same relief, as prayed for in the present petition, at the appropriate stage, i.e after the conclusion of the investigation proceedings.

- 4. Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.
- 5. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
