In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that though the petitioner has already retired on attaining the age of superannuation on 30.04.2023 but her pensionary benefits have not been released to her even though, there are no disciplinary proceedings pending against her.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioner has been re-considered and an order has already been passed approving the release of the pensionary benefits in favour of the petitioner and the same have already been sent to Accountant General, Haryana for the grant of approval so that payment could be released in favour of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Nar Singh, Deputy Superintendent, Mr. Kuldeep, Superintendent and Mr. Sumit Kumar, Legal Counselor, Women & Child Welfare Department, further submits that the benefit, which the department has to release in favour of the petitioner such as leave encashment etc., the same will be released within a period of two weeks from today.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that appropriate direction be given to Accountant General, Haryana to approve the claim of the petitioner qua the pension immediately as the petitioner has no other means to survive and is without any benefit for the last more than 04 months.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is claiming the pensionary benefits, the Accountant General, Haryana is requested that appropriate approval to the claim of the petitioner for the release of the pensionary benefits be given at an early date and not later than a period of two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
