This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the letters dated 06.01.2017 and 06.03.2017 issued by respondent no.3 vide which the petitioner has been asked to deposit an amount of Rs.40,91,553/-.
