The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to conduct an inquiry against the private respondents No.8 to 11 for misusing the Government Funds and also for committing theft of wood/trees lying in the Canal Rest House, Rohti Division.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner had obtained time to place on record the necessary documents to establish commission of offence by the private respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that he has now received the said documents and that translation of the said documents would take some time and therefore, he seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action but with better particulars.

The aforesaid prayer is not opposed or objected to by the learned State counsel.
