The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, praying for issuance of direction to the official respondent No. 2 to further issue directions/restrain respondent No. 3 not to give custody of petitioners No. 2 and 3 to respondent No. 4 forcefully without their being any orders of any competent Court of jurisdiction. It has further been prayed that direction be also issued to respondents No. 2 and 3 to take necessary action on the representation dated 21.04.2023 and 23.05.2023 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) filed by the petitioners, as per law.

Keeping in view the vague contents of the petition and nature of the prayer made therein, this Court does not find it appropriate to interfere in the matter.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, in accordance with law.
