SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner has assailed the final seniority list as existed on 01.01.2008 (Annexure P-10) alleging that the petitioner was regularised in service as Fireman on 30.09.2003 and it was duly mentioned at Serial No.10 in the tentative seniority list (Annexure P-9) dated 10.12.2007, whereas the final seniority list has been published qua 9 persons only for the reasons best known to the respondents.

A written statement has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 stating that the petitioner namely Bahadur Singh submitted an affidavit that he will not claim seniority on account of his previous transfer and harping on that affidavit, the respondents-State has pressed that since no seniority list was prepared as on 01.01.1998, as such the table prepared by the petitioner is based upon assumptions

and is imaginary.

Be that as it may, counsel for the petitioner very fairly concedes that the petitioner submitted a legal notice dated 17.12.2017, which has been replied, but no formal order has been passed on the same. The respondent No.3-Deputy Commissioner Kurukshetra is directed to pass a speaking order, after considering the pleas taken in the legal notice as well as in the instant petition in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from today with a copy of the order so passed supplied to the petitioner.

Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
