The instant writ petition had been filed for quashing the complaint dated 14.10.2021 (Annexure P-10) lodged at Police Station, Balachaur, District S.B.S. Nagar, against the petitioners being a subsequent complaint notwithstanding the fact that representation dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-4) had already been consigned.

Short reply on behalf of respondent No.1 filed by way of affidavit of Devinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Balachaur, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Nagar, today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

It has been averred in paragraphs No.5 and 6 of the aforesaid short reply that the complaint submitted by the respondent had been marked to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Balachaur who conducted the inquiry thoroughly and sought legal opinion from the Deputy District Attorney. It was noticed that civil suit has already been filed by the respondent No.2 for seeking declaration that the registered sale deeds are null and void and the same are pending before the Civil Courts at Balachaur. The complaint dated 18.10.2021 was thereafter ordered to be consigned on 14.05.2022.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the respondent-State, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners does not press the instant petition, at this stage.

Disposed of accordingly.
