Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition despite the fact that the petitioner was eligible to compete for Group-D post as advertised vide Advertisement No. 4 of 2018 and has secured higher merit position, he has not been selected, whereas the candidates having lesser merit than the petitioner have already been selected and allowed to join, which act of the respondents is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 11.07.2023 (Annexure P-16) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 11.07.2023 (Annexure P-16) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that certain facts have come to the knowledge of the petitioner after filing the representation dated 11.07.2023 (Annexure P-16), hence, petitioner be given liberty to supplement the representation dated 11.07.2023 (Annexure P-16), which will be done within a period of seven days from today.

Petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
