This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 11.01.2018 (Annexure P-9) passed by respondent No.1 whereby the appeal filed by the petitioner has been dismissed and order dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2, whereby, the petitioner has been suspended from the post of Sarpanch with immediate effect.

Learned State Counsel has pointed out that in the present case, challenge is to the suspension order whereas term of the petitioner has elapsed in July, 2018 and thus, the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has no instructions in the said regard.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is however granted to the petitioner to file an application for restoration of the present petition or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives to the petitioner.
