This is a petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 25.07.2019 passed by the Civil Judge (Senior Division), Ludhiana.

In compliance of the order dated 17.09.2019 passed by this Court, this case was sent to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for exploring the possibility of settlement between the parties. In response thereto, a report dated 13.03.2020 was received. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 08.07.2022, following order was passed by this Court:-

“As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, to which the parties were referred to, they have amicably resolved all their disputes.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that during the pendency of the instant revision petition, respondent No.1 has expired.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, however, seeks an adjournment to get necessary instructions in the matter.

Adjourned to 15.07.2022.

It is made clear that no further adjournment shall be granted and the learned counsel for the petitioner shall complete his instructions positively before the next date of hearing.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.1-Vivek Sharma has since expired. Therefore, he does not want to press the present petition and he be permitted to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for.
