Today, learned State counsel informs that the matter is now fixed for recording the statement of the accused in terms of Section 313 Cr.P.C. on 17.04.2023.

In view of the aforestated position, this Court finds that the trial is virtually at its fag end. Having regard to the nature of the offences and the fact that the trial is virtually at a concluding stage, this Court does not deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail at this stage. The petition, as such, is dismissed.
