1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to issue him passport.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent has not issued passport on the ground that he is not having Aadhar Card.

3. Per contra, learned counsel for the respondents who on advance notice is present in Court submits that there is difference in place of birth of the petitioner in the passport which was earlier issued, thus, petitioner has been asked to explain his position.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would appear before passport authority and clarify his position.

5. In the wake of statements of both sides, the petitioner is

directed to appear before passport authority on 25.09.2023 alongwith all the requisite documents. On doing so the passport authority shall pass an appropriate order within 6 weeks thereafter.
