AVNEESH JHINGAN J.(Oral)

1. This is the second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.28 dated 19.03.2021 under Sections 22-C and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.
2. An affidavit on behalf of respondent-State has been filed and the same is taken on record, copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.
- 3.. Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Kewal Singh, submits that cross examination of only one of the prosecution witness is pending and rest of the prosecution witnesses have already been examined.
4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to approach the trial Court for expeditious conclusion of trial.

- 5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
- 6. There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the court concerned for accommodating the dates for expeditious conclusion of trial, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
- 7. Since the main case has been withdrawn, pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
