By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C for seeking the quashing of the FIR bearing No.01 dated 03.02.2021 registered at Police Station NRI, District Kapurthala, under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC as well as all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Mr. Iqbal Singh Mann, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Bhuvnesh Kumar from the afore-referred Police Station, he informs the Court that the Challan in connection with the criminal case under reference, is almost ready and the same shall be presented in the Court within two weeks.

3. In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage, while submitting that if there need be, the petitioner would file a fresh petition for seeking the same relief, as prayed for in this petition, at the appropriate stage, i.e after the submission of the Challan in the Competent Court.

4. Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

5. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
