This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of complaint/inquiry pending before the Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that in the present case, only notice (Annexure P-13) has been issued to the petitioner which also has not been challenged in the present writ petition and instead of joining the said proceedings and filing a reply to the same, the petitioner has chosen to file the present writ petition.

Learned State Counsel has further submitted that in case, the petitioner files reply in the said proceedings then same would be

considered and further proceedings would be taken, in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition with liberty to file reply before the authorities and in case, any order, after following due procedure, is passed against the petitioner, then, liberty be granted to the petitioner to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
