On March 07, 2018, this Court had passed the following
order:-

***“Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for
time to produce the Rules on the basis of which he has
claimed that certain teachers are working on deputation
beyond the period provided therein.***

Adjourned to 18.04.2018.”

Since, despite opportunity, the order, extracted above, had
not been complied with, the matter was adjourned *sine die*, on April 18,
2018, to be listed upon compliance. Concededly, the position is not any
different even today, as the order dated March 07, 2018 (*ibid*), continues
to await compliance. As the matter remained pending for more than five
years, after obtaining orders from Hon’ble the Chief Justice on the
administrative side, the office has relisted the petition.

In the wake of the above, we are of the view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the matter pending for an indefinite period. *Ex facie*, the petitioner has shown no interest/inclination to pursue the petition. Thus, the petition, with efflux of time, appears to have lost its efficacy and is rendered infructuous.

Disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
