JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that grievance of the petitioner would be redressed, if respondents are directed to re-consider representation of the petitioner in the light of the medical report.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that if petitioner files a fresh representation, it would be considered and disposed of within four weeks from the date of its filing.
3. In the wake of statements of learned counsels for the parties, the present petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh representation. On doing so, the respondents shall dispose of the same within four weeks from the date of filing representation.
