HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for quashing of FIR No.99 registered under Section 304-A of the IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala.

2. At the outset, learned State counsel submits that after the investigation, no substance has been found in the allegations and the cancellation report has already been submitted before the competent Court of law on 23.05.2017, hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has already been found innocent by the Investigating Agency.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the cancellation report has already been submitted but the petitioner is being harassed from the last 18 years approximately, hence, direction be

issued to the trial Court to take into consideration the said cancellation report and pass appropriate order thereupon in a time bound manner so that petitioner does not suffer further prejudice.

4. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to pass appropriate order on the cancellation report submitted by the investigating agency within a period of one month from the receipt of copy of this order, after following due process as envisaged under law.
