Present petition has been filed by one Parmanand, who was not the petitioner in CWP-19822-2018, which was disposed of vide order dated 19.12.2018 directing the respondents to hold and complete the election process of the Municipal Council, Rewari in accordance with law, on the existing delimitation of wards.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of affidavit of Director, Urban Local Bodies, Haryana, submits that on 25.04.2019, by passing a speaking order, representation of the petitioners i.e. Dalip Kumar and Ashok was decided. It is further submitted that election has been conducted and result has already been declared. It is also submitted that petitioner Parmanand has even

filed CWP-32013-2019 and CWP-6376-2020 with identical prayer, after election process for Municipal Council, Rewari started. It is next submitted that prayer in the said writ petitions was identical that election was not being held on the existing delimitation of wards.

Learned State counsel has further submitted that writ petitioners i.e. Dalip Singh and Ashok have never filed COCP challenging non-compliance of the order dated 19.12.2018 alleging that election of Municipal Council, Rewari was not held on the existing delimitation of wards, therefore, the present petitioner has no locus standi to file this petition.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed.
