1. On 18.05.2011, the ex-parte decree for injunction was passed with respect to a parcel of land, directing the defendant therein, not to interfere in the possession of the plaintiffs. The petitioners herein though not a party to the judgment and decree, filed an appeal alongwith an application for condonation of delay, which has been dismissed by the First Appellate Court.

2. Learned counsel representing the petitioners, after arguing for some time, prays for permission to withdraw the revision petition in order to avail alternative remedy, as the decree has never been passed against the petitioners.
