While issuing notice of motion on 21.12.2022, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter stands amicably resolved amongst the parties and some other co-accused had already been granted interim bail by this Court keeping in view the factum of compromise. Learned counsel in this regard has drawn the attention of this Court to orders dated 24.06.2022 and 30.06.2022 (Annexures P-4 & P-5 respectively).

Notice of motion for 18.05.2023.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide

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by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2)
Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish Singh, has stated that pursuant to the order dated 21.12.2022, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
3. In view of above, the interim order dated 21.12.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
4. Petition stands disposed off.
