ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 08.08.2022 passed in CWP-13750-2022, vide which status quo with regard to possession, as it existed on that day, was directed to be maintained till the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that while violating the said order, the respondents have demolished graveyard and cut the trees.

However, it is admitted fact that vide order dated 20.04.2023, aforesaid writ petition stands dismissed, directing SHO of the local police station to consider the threat perception, if any and take appropriate action.

A perusal of this order shows that proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. are initiated by submitting the Kalandra before the Executive Magistrate concerned.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the Executive Magistrate with regard to his claim, which will also be decided, in accordance with law.
