The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.39 dated 28.05.2023 registered under Sections 307, 324, 148, 149, 506 of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Sadiq Faridkot, District Faridkot.

2. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that incident took place on 28.05.2023 and attribution is to co-accused Akashdeep Singh who gave various kirtch blows on the person of Kuldeep Singh. Another attribution is to co-accused Mohinder Singh who allegedly had embraced Kuldeep Singh from behind when Akashdeep Singh had stabbed the kirtch in his chest and stomach. Learned counsel further contends that only attribution to the petitioner is that she was present at the time of occurrence.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Randeep Singh Khaira, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on

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behalf of respondent- State.

5. Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid facts, which have also been noticed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot in order dated 21.06.2023 (Annexure P-2).

6. Custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel reveals that petitioner is in custody for the last 02 months and 25 days with no criminal antecedents.

7. Having regard to the role attributed to the petitioner and all the circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
