The petitioners are seeking direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to cancel the license of respondent No. 3-M/s. Discovery Wines or any other alcohol vend at Sector-43, Golf Course Road, Gurugram.

Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 1 and has handed over a letter dated 25.08.2023 to learned counsel for the petitioners and to the Court as well. The said letter is taken on record as Annexure R-1. As per the said letter, wine shop is located on the land belonging to HSVP and it is existing across 10 meter wide road and 13 meter away from petitioner's plot i.e. Plot No. 6-P Sector 43 Gurugram and approximately 30 meters away from the plot No. 4-P, Sector 43, Gurugram and no trees have been removed from the site. He further states that only temporary construction is permitted as per clause 10

of the guidelines dated 16.07.2021 (at page no. 20 of the paper book).

Keeping in view the above fact, this petition is being disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to make a representation to respondent No.1, if any, on the ground that he is running hospital nearby to the wine shop.
