1. The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. as warrants of arrest have been issued against him in CRA-112 of 2017 filed on 18.03.2017 pending in the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Narnaul for 02.09.2023 in Complaint case bearing No.NACT/1219/2013 registered under Sections 138/142 of the NI Act titled as 'Hans Raj Vs. M/s Saheed Raj Filling Station Rewari'.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is ready to appear, and surrender before the Court below within 07 days from today. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Court below and with directions to the Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Court below within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the

petitioner.

4. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Court below within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner move an application for bail before the Court below, the same shall be decided expeditiously, by the Court preferably, in accordance with law.
