1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 05.06.2023 passed by the Ld. Appellate Court in appeal bearing No. CRA/69/2023 titled as **“Parveen Kumari VS. Vijay Kumar”** and all other consequential orders, i.e. order dated 28.07.2023 (Annexure P-4), whereby, the petitioner was directed to deposit 20% of the cheque amount.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press for the present petition. However, he submits that the time period granted by the first appellate Court may kindly be extended, keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

4. At this stage, there is no need to issue notice to the respondent as only time period for depositing the 20% of the cheque amount has to be extended.

5. As per the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is a poor lady and is not in a position to deposit the amount of 20% of the cheque amount within the period granted by the trial Court. Apart from that, the present petitioner/appellant is having good case on the strength of merits of the case.

6. Without commenting anything on the merits of the present case, the petitioner is granted a period of four weeks from today to deposit 20% of the cheque amount, as ordered by the first appellate Court vide order dated 05.06.2023.

7. Order dated 05.06.2023 passed by the first appellate Court is accordingly modified to the extent as indicated above.

8. The petition stands disposed off.
