Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that petitioner had applied for the post of Operation Theatre Assistant in pursuance to the Advertisement No. 15 of 2019 in the Category of Dependent of Ex-Servicemen (General), whereas, the petitioner has not been considered in the Category of Dependent of Ex-Servicemen (General) but has been considered in General Category despite the fact that the post of Dependent of Ex-Servicemen (General) is still lying vacant even after accommodating one of the dependent of Freedom Fighter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even as of now, as one post is lying vacant, the petitioner has filed representations, copies of which have been appended as Annexures P-8 and P-9 raising the grievance as raised in the present petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage,

in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representations Annexures P-8 and P-9 by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representations Annexures P-8 and P-9 have been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same are still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
