1. The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to quash the seniority list issued on 31.07.2016. From a perusal of the memo of parties, it is evident that the petitioner has not impleaded the employees who will be adversely affected by the decision. Hence, the writ petition is bad for the non-joinder of necessary parties.

2. In any case, the petitioner is a member of the District Cadre. He was appointed in the District Hoshiarpur. Subsequently, on his request, he was shifted from District Cadre, Hoshiarpur to District Cadre, Kapurthala. It has been stated by the respondent-State that the petitioner gave undertaking that he will not claim the benefit of seniority of the service rendered in Hoshiarpur.

3. In view of the aforesaid facts, no ground to issue the writ, as prayed for, is made out.

4. Hence, dismissed.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
