The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0320 dated 02.09.2022 under Sections 380, 454 IPC and Section 34 IPC added later on registered at Police Station Sector 13/17, District Panipat.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 21.09.2022 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 21.09.2022 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 21.09.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
