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VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 to 3 for protection of her life and liberty as she apprehends danger at the instance of respondent Nos. 4 to 7 and further issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to initiate action against the private respondents on the basis of the representation, Annexure P-1.

2. Affidavit of Deepak Hilori, Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur on behalf of the State has been taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the complaint submitted by the petitioner has been considered and filed. Furthermore, the affidavit also indicates that ASI Ayub Masih and ASI Harnek Singh were found negligent in performance of their duties which resulted in delay in submission of the status report. Departmental proceedings have been initiated against the aforesaid officials in terms of the office order No. 23746-50/B dated

18.11.2023.

4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy as may be available in accordance with law.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
