The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to quash the impugned order dated 16.02.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, whereby the bail order of the petitioner was cancelled, his bail bonds and surety bonds were ordered to be forfeited and the non-bailable warrants were issued against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court on 29.08.2023 and has been admitted to interim bail.

In view of the order dated 29.08.2023 passed by the trial Court, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 24.08.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute. It is made clear that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the learned trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent before the trial Court, without prior permission of the Court.
