1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 25.11.2020 (Annexure P-11) whereby respondent No.2/District Magistrate, Hisar has cancelled No Objection Certificate granted to the petitioner.

2. Mr. Ashish Kapoor, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that District Magistrate, Hisar by impugned order dated 25.11.2020 had cancelled No Objection Certificate on the ground that petitioner has not submitted NOC from the Forest Department. The Forest Department has issued NOC and it duly stands received by District Magistrate, Hisar.

3. Mr. Raman Sharma, learned State counsel does not dispute the afore-stated factual position and submits that District Magistrate,

Hisar would reconsider case of the petitioner in the light of NOC received from the Forest Department.

4. In view of statements of both sides, the impugned order dated 25.11.2020 (Annexure P-11) is hereby set aside and respondent No.2/District Magistrate, Hisar is directed to pass a fresh order after considering NOC received from the Forest Department. Needful be done within 6 weeks from today.
