Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, various reliefs have been sought in the present petition but the present petition may kindly be considered only for the grant of relief of the Leave Travel Concession after rendering 4 years of service keeping in view the instructions which have been issued by the Government of Haryana dated 14.02.2023, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the grievance raised in the present petition, the petitioner has already served a legal notice on 01.07.2023 upon the respondents, copy of which has been appended as Annexure-1, which is still pending consideration

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice and submits that even the department has sought permission for the release of the benefit but as the administrative department has not passed any

approval for the release of the said benefit, the same has not been released despite being eligible. He further submits that in case, the department has received the legal notice dated 01.07.2023, Annexure P-1 and same is still pending consideration with the department, an appropriate order on the said legal notice will be passed by respondent No. 2 qua the Leave Travel Concession and dress allowance within a period of 2 months of the receipt of the copy of this order by passing appropriate speaking order and in case, after the passing of the speaking order, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will be extended within a further period of 4 weeks in accordance with law.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
