Affidavit of the Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula, dated 21.03.2023, in pursuance to and in compliance with the order dated 14.03.2023, has been filed in Court, which is taken on record, where in para-3, it has been stated that all basic amenities of civil works have been provided.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the

respondents have complied with the requirements with regard to there being basic amenities available.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the petitioner(s) would accept the offer, which has been made by the counsel for the respondents, as has been made in the affidavit dated 26.09.2022, in para-4 whereof, the petitioner(s) were to be given a refund of the amount with interest @5.5% per annum as per policy.

He, on this basis, submits that the petitioner(s) would surrender both the plots and would seek the refund of the amount along with interest.

In the light of the above statement of the learned senior counsel for the petitioner(s), the plots are permitted to be surrendered. Petitioner(s) be refunded the amount, as deposited by them, along with interest @5.5% within a period of six weeks.

The writ petitions are disposed of with liberty to the petitioner (s) to move an appropriate application for refund of the amount.

In view of the disposal of the main cases, all pending Civil Misc. Applications stand disposed of.
