Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer to award of ten marks to the petitioner on account of disease of Debilitating Disorders in terms of the online transfer policy, dated 22.06.2023 (Annexure P-2). The petitioner is suffering from chronic heart disease, and has also been issued a valid medical certificate in that regard, dated 16.08.2023 (Annexure P-7). On that basis, he has requested for correction of his score vide representation dated 19.08.2023 (Annexure P-8), but no decision has been taken so far.

2. He further submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to decide the pending representation, dated 19.08.2023 (Annexure P-8), within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Ravinder Singh Budhwar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, appearing on advance notice, submits that the pending representation dated 19.08.2023 shall be decided by respondent No.2 expeditiously.

In view thereof, without going into the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Higher Education Department, to consider and decide the pending representation dated 19.08.2023, by passing a speaking order thereupon, within a period of four weeks from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
