Petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.47 dated 28.04.2023, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 324, 323, 506 (Section 307 added subsequently) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, '*the IPC*'), registered at Police Station Maloya, U.T. Chandigarh.

2. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer of petitioner, learned counsel, on instructions, submits that petitioner shall surrender before the Court concerned, but his regular bail be decided expeditiously.
