Instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C. has been preferred by the petitioner seeking direction to the respondents not to initiate and inquire into multiple complaints filed by respondent No. 6.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that civil litigation between the petitioner and respondent No. 6 is pending adjudication at Faridabad but in order to harass the petitioner, respondent No. 6, namely, Bhasir Khan, is moving the complaints one after the other to the police authorities.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that to be precise four complaints moved by respondent No. 6 to the police authorities at Ballabgarh, District Faridabad, have already been filed and another petition moved by respondent No. 6 seeking registration of the complaint under Section 156(3) Cr. P.C has been dismissed by the concerned Illaqa Magistrate, and now respondent No. 6 has moved another

complaint dated 18.07.2023 (Annexure P-6). He further contends that in

order to bring all such facts to the notice of the authorities, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 20.07.2023 (Annexure P-7) to ACP, Ballabgarh, District Faridabad, but till date no action has been taken thereon.

- 4. Notice of motion.
- 5. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 5.
- 6. After hearing the respective submissions and considering the averments made in the petition, present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 3-ACP, Ballabgarh, District Faridabad, to consider the representation moved by the petitioner dated 20.07.2023 (Annexure P-7) and dispose it of in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner, by giving an opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.
- 7. Decision, so taken, be intimated to the petitioner as well.
- 8. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
