SANJIV BERRY, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 128 dated 13.10.2021 under Section 304 IPC, registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.04.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sher Singh, Police Station Rampura Phul, submits that in pursuance of the order dated 19.04.2022, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation. He further submits that after the completion of the investigation, challan has been presented in the Court.

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4. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 19.04.2022, passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 19.04.2022 is hereby made absolute, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C. Further, he will not tamper with the evidence and influence the witnesses; shall cooperate with the investigation as and when so required.
5. The petition stands allowed.
