Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondent i.e. Municipal Corporation, Faridabad to allot the plot to the petitioner.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that earlier RSA No.2937 of 2011 was filed which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 22.11.2017. He contends that the petitioner is duly entitled for the allotment of the plot however, the same has not been allotted to him till date. He also submits that the petitioner has already deposited the requisite amount with the respondent in the year 1985 which fact is supported by Annexure P-4.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 has submitted that this Court in the said RSA relegated the petitioner for the alternative

remedy but till date it has not filed any such petition or representation for the redressal of its grievance. He submits that if any such petition/representation is filed, the respondent No.1 would deal with the same in accordance with law.

Heard. After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file the petition/representation for the redressal of its grievance before respondent No.1 within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If any such petition/representation is filed, respondent No.1 would decide the same keeping in view the all facts & circumstances of the case and also the record of this case within eight weeks from the date of filing of the representation. Petitioner would be at liberty to pursue its remedies as per law in case it has any surviving grievances.

In view of the disposal of the main petition, all pending applications stand disposed of.
